Last week, the House passed a bill that is now heading to President Biden's desk that will give family members of victims of the horrific bombing of Pan Am Flight 103 over Lockerbie, Scotland, remote access to observe proceedings against a terrorist who has been extradited to the U.S. to face charges.

Now that we know that proceedings can be made accessible, it's time to make sure that the entire country can observe the Federal Election Interference Case against Donald Trump. The former President has been charged by a grand jury with four crimes. Two relate to the disruption of Congress' certification of the electoral vote on January 6th. One alleges a scheme to defraud the United States through a sustained effort to impede the collection, counting and certification of votes in the 2020 election. The fourth charge accuses Trump of a conspiracy to deprive citizens of a right secured under federal law - specifically, the right to vote and to have one's vote counted.

If you believe former President Trump is being persecuted for political reasons, and think he's being railroaded, then expose the evidence for everyone to see. Since the case is against the people of the United States, we should have the right to observe the Federal Election Interference Case. Therefore, as my representative, I respectfully request you make a motion in the House to make the trial proceeding accessible to the people.
